By his sophomore year of college, he had found a few gigs at some local bars in the Louisville and Lexington areas and developed a fan-base that eventually landed him on some of the biggest stages in the business, having opened for over 50 major artists such as Montgomery Gentry, Craig Morgan, Jamey Johnson, and Kellie Pickler. Playing over 230 shows per year, this self-made, rising Country Artist has a work-ethic like none other, and a growing legion of fans behind him.
